

The records of the International Tracing Service contain information on an estimated 13.5 million former persecutees of the National-Socialist Regime. Since there may be several sources of information on a single person, the index contains 43 million cards.

= 31,300 microfiches

– Since 1943, it has

= dispatched 6.5 million reports for which

= 1.6 million individual personal files were opened, to which – should new inquiries be made, additional information be acquired or a tracing request be made – immediate access may be obtained.

At present, with a total of 212.5 permanent posts, 244 persons are employed to carry out the evaluation and classification of the documents. In addition, eight trainees are employed at the International Tracing Service.
