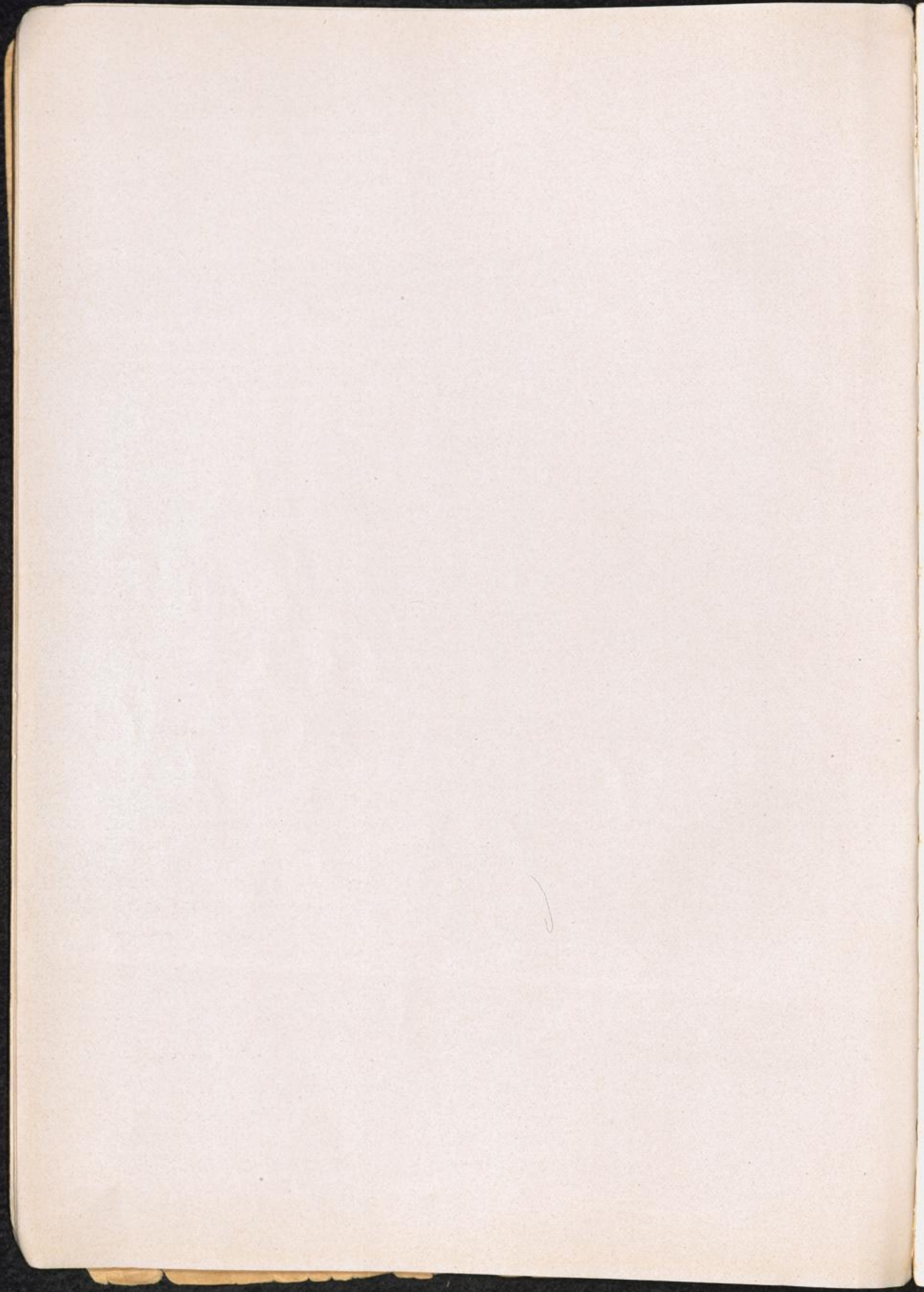

The main concentration camp Mauthausen was situated on the border of the two villages Mauthausen and Marbach, in the vicinity of the quarry Wiener Graben.

In the ITS records, the CC is first mentioned as existing in July 38. The treatment in Mauthausen and its Kdo.'s was especially hard, even as compared with other CC's (US War Crimes Comm.). The current number in the prisoners registration book reached 139000 in April 45 (International Red Cross Comm. Service Watson). Prisoners arriving with the Code „Kugel“ -bullet- marked on their transfer papers were executed soon after their arrival, without entering their names into the prisoners register; if entered by mistake, the names were crossed out and the numbers given to other prisoners. Thus an estimated number of 25000 pris. do not appear in the CC's registers or death books (Former inmate of the Mauthausen Schreibstube). As for the use of the prisoners for work in the armament industry, Mauthausen had to provide with manpower a territory covering the former districts Wien, Niederdonau, Oberdonau, Steiermark, Kaernten of the "Ostmark" and the environments of Passau from Bavaria.

The following is the official list compiled by the Mauthausen Section of the Dachau Detachment of all camps, Kdo.'s and Sub-Kdo.'s of the Mauthausen Concentration Camp ring. The camps designated by capital letters alone (A, B, etc.) are all Kdo.'s of Mauthausen, the camps designated by a capital letter and a number (A-1, D-1) are Sub-Kdo.'s of the Kdo.'s, designated by the corresponding capital letter. Kdo.'s were usually in charge of an officer. A Sub-Kdo. usually was in the charge of a non-commissioned officer. The list has numerical and alphabetical order.

In the original number-books of Mauthausen the remark "† ERHOLUNGSHEIM" with date is often found. It may be assumed that Hartheim and "Erholungsheim" are the same.

The criminal police Linz investigated Hartheim crematory and supplied a list of approximately 1500 civilians who were cremated in Hartheim between 1939 and 1945. According to the lists all these deaths had occurred in Linz, Waldegg 82. The cause of death was usually given as mental, TB or other incurable diseases. It is assumed that Linz, Waldegg 82 was an extermination center for the unfit.
