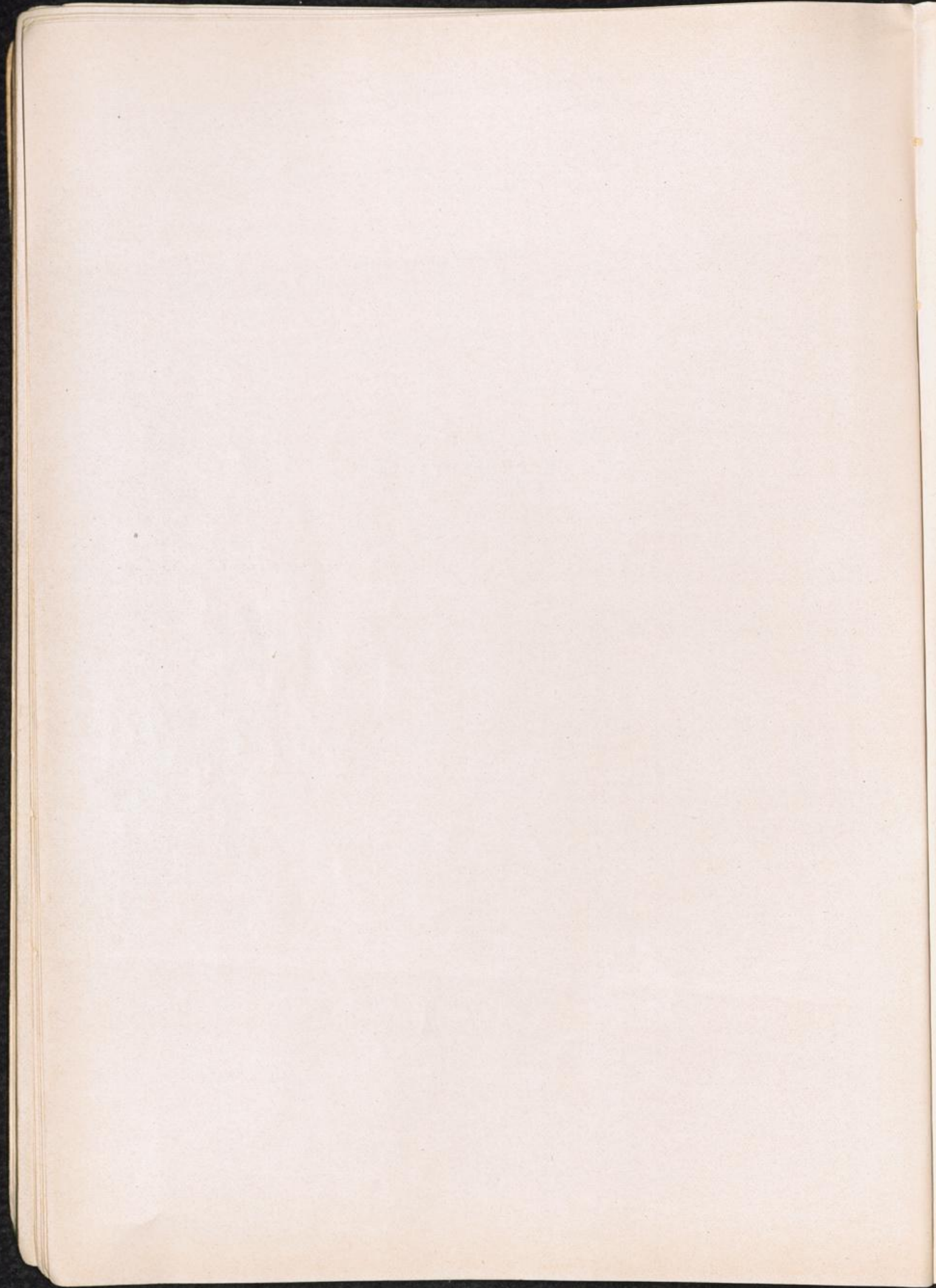

In the old Fortress of Terezin.

CC Theresienstadt. A ghetto-type camp, it was established in Nov. 41 for the purpose of receiving transports of Jews evacuated from Germany and other German occupied countries. Until 20. 4. 45, 140000 persons arrived here on regular transports; of these 88000 were deported to the concentration camps in Poland and the Baltic countries, 35000 died in the camp, and 17000 were liberated. After April 20th until the day of liberation on 8. 5. 45 various evacuation transports from other CC's arrived in Terezin bringing in about 14000 prisoners; most of these were liberated. ("Terezin Ghetto", a booklet published by the Czechoslovak Ministry of Social Welfare in Oct. 1945).

Invoices were sent to the address: Der Reichsminister fuer Ruestung und Kriegsproduktion, z. H. der Mineraloelgesellschaft Bauleitung "Richard" (Flossenbuerg invoices). Part of the Kdo. was working on the construction of a factory "Elsabe", and part of it on the "Elsabe" production. First mentioned on 8. 7. 44, the Kdo. had a strength of 1500 pris., this number was increased to 4000 on 22. 1. 45 and 5000 men and 300 women pris. on 13. 4. 45, when the Kdo. was last mentioned. For accounts purpose, the prisoners were allocated to three groups:

Kdo. B 5 employed at the construction and the camp maintenance,
Kdo. "Richard" working on account of the construction contractor,
Kdo. "Elsabe" Fertigung, working on production.
