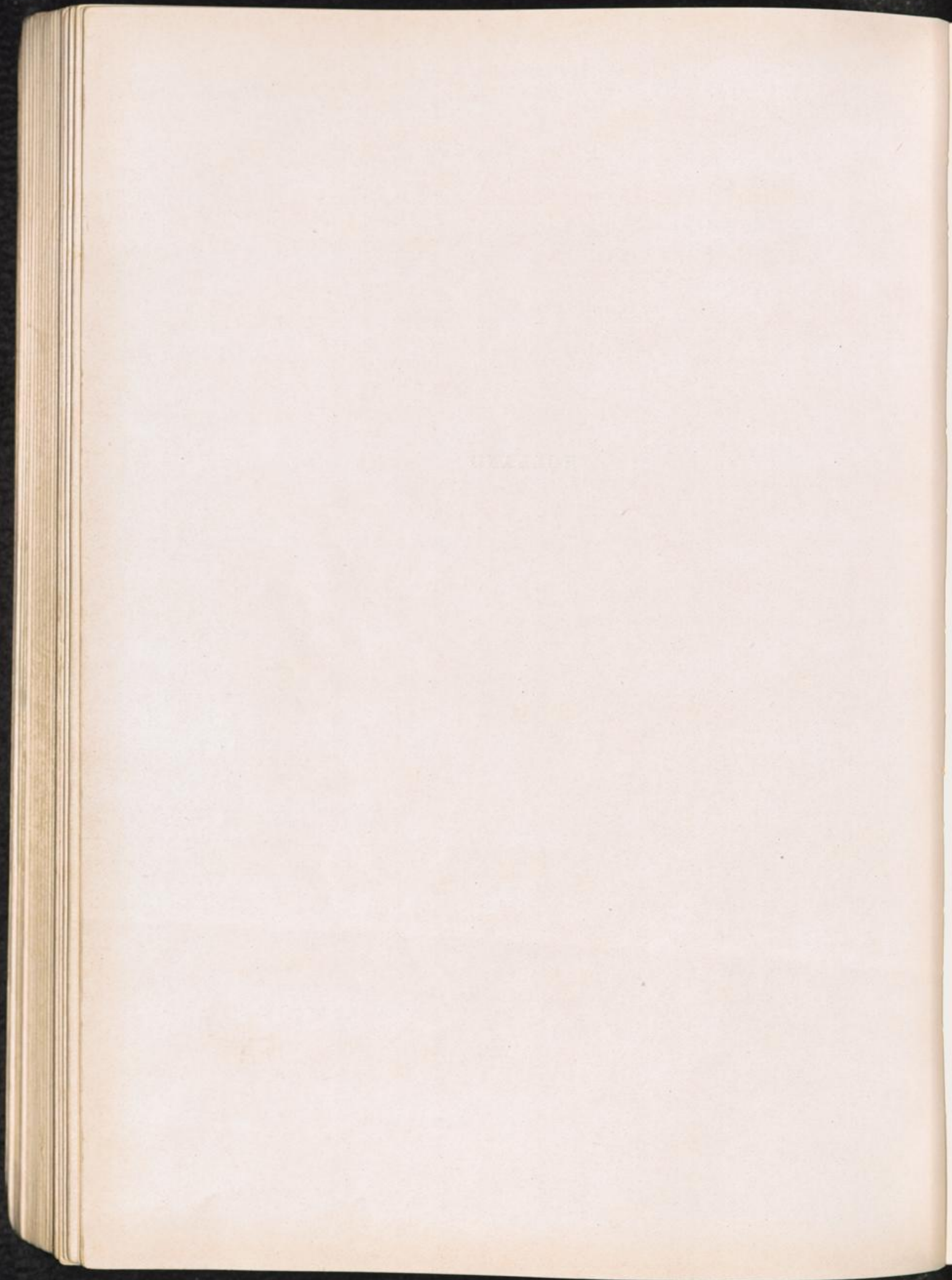

After the German occupation of Holland, May 40, the "Sicherungsstab" established a "Polizeihaftlager" at Vught, 2 miles from s'Hertogenbosch. Last mentioned on 11. 10. 40 (Gestapo files Duesseldorf). The CC Herzogenbusch was established on 5. 1. 43 as transit camp for Jews on their way to the Eastern CC's (Letter RSHA). On 13. 3. 43 the Gestapo were informed that prisoners given less severe sentences — such as Lagerstufe I and II — could be sent to CC Herzogenbusch (Gestapo files Duesseldorf). 40 French nationals were shot in CC Vught shortly after the invasion (letter of former inmate).
