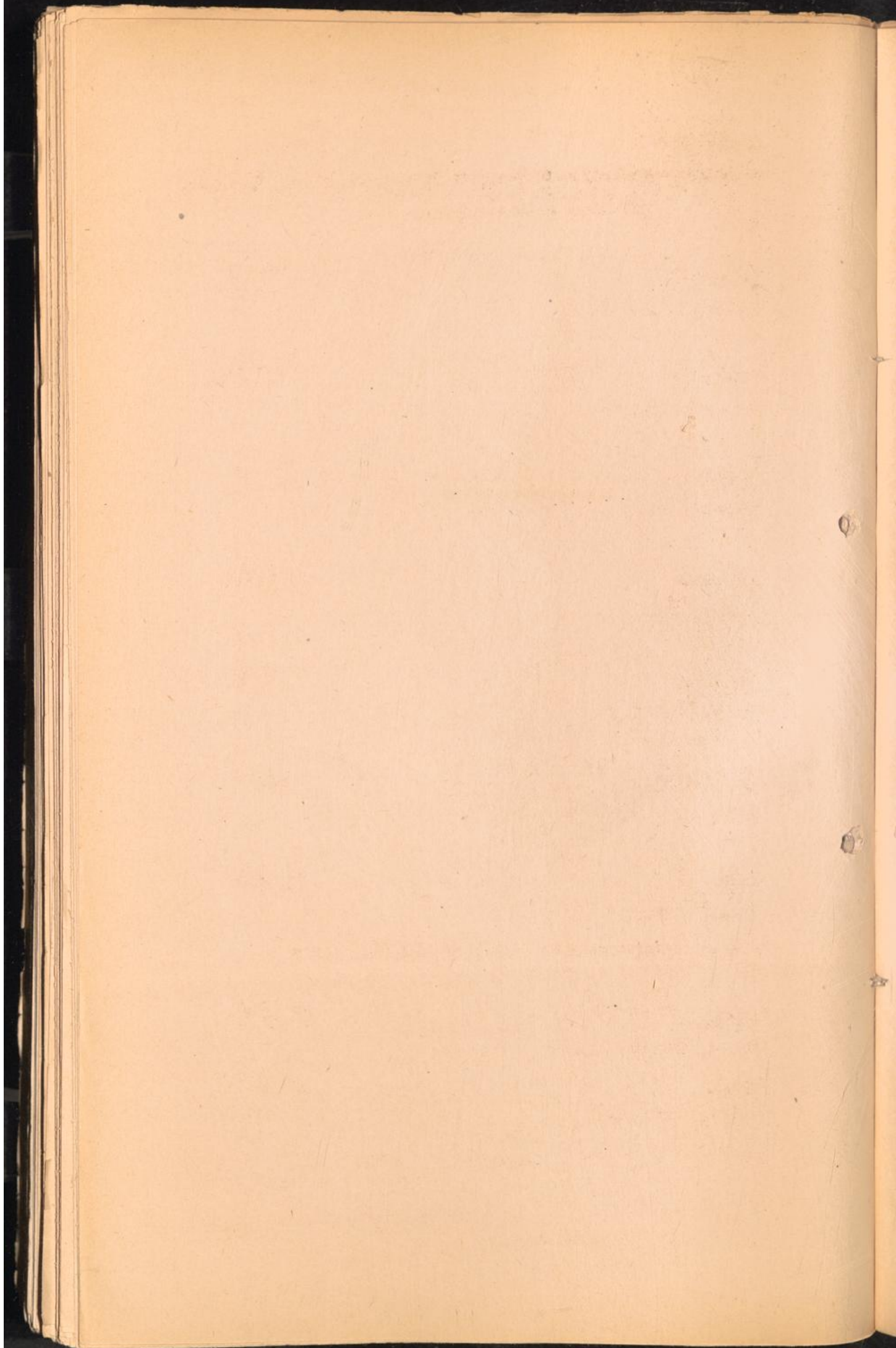

After the German occupation of Holland, May 40, the "Sicherungsstab" established a "Polizeihaftlager" at Vught, 2 miles from s'Hertogenbosch. Last mentioned on 11.10.40 (Gestapo files Duesseldorf). The CC Herzogenbusch was established as CC-transit camp for Jews on their way to the eastern CC's, on 5.1.43 (Letter RSHA). The CC Herzogenbusch was open for receipt of prisoners, "Lagerstufe I and II" on 13.3.43. (Gestapo files Duesseldorf). 40 French nationals were shot in CC Vught shortly after the invasion (Letter of former inmate.)
