On 5. 10. 1938 the camp had a strength of 565 prisoners (Mauthausen strength report). Mauthausen was liberated on May 6th, 1945 by the US-Army (Statement of Lt. Col. Seibel, US-Army).

EBENSEE Krs. Gmunden US Zone N 48/V 53

Add: CC Kdo. of Mauthausen. Preparations for building the camp of the CC Kdo. Ebensee started on 18. 11. 1943, after the arrival of the first transport of 63 men, mostly professional workers, officeworkers and organizers from the CC Kdo. Redl-Zipf.

The main purpose of CC Kdo. Ebensee was to construct tunnels, to be used for armament work. The tunnels were to be constructed by CC pris. only, but under the supervision of civilian engineers employed by German constructing firms. The more important civilian firms working on this project were: Siemens-Bau-Union, Siemens-Schuckert, Grossdeutscher Schachtbau, Hinteregger & Fischer, Holzmann, Polensky, Deutsche Bergbau Hermann Goering — Nibelungen-Werk etc.

On January 17. 1944 about 500 pris. arrived in the camp, to work in the stone quarries, followed in February 1944 by another 350 pris., mostly Italians.

By June 44 the effective strength of CC Kdo. Ebensee had risen to 8000 pris.
