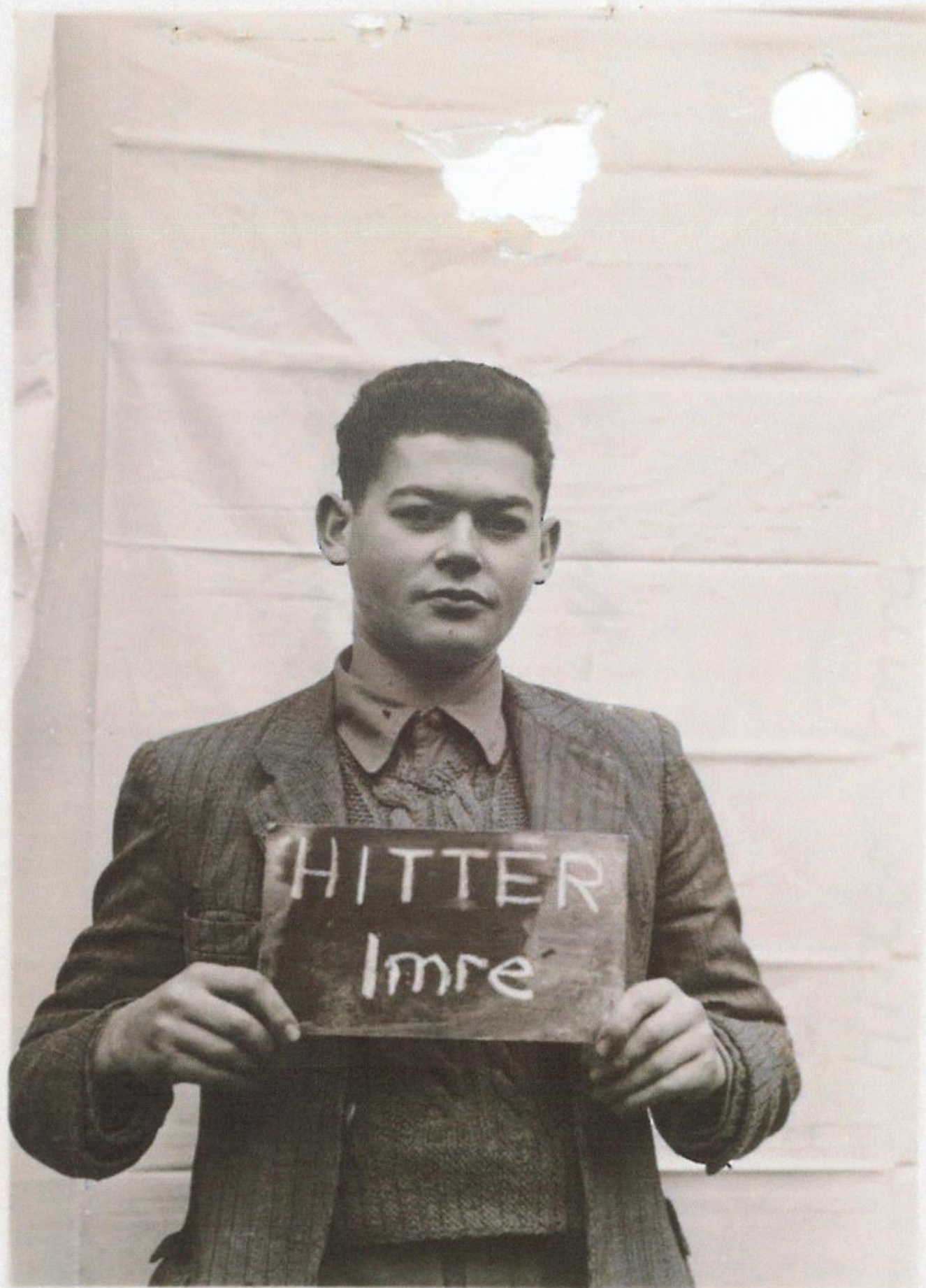

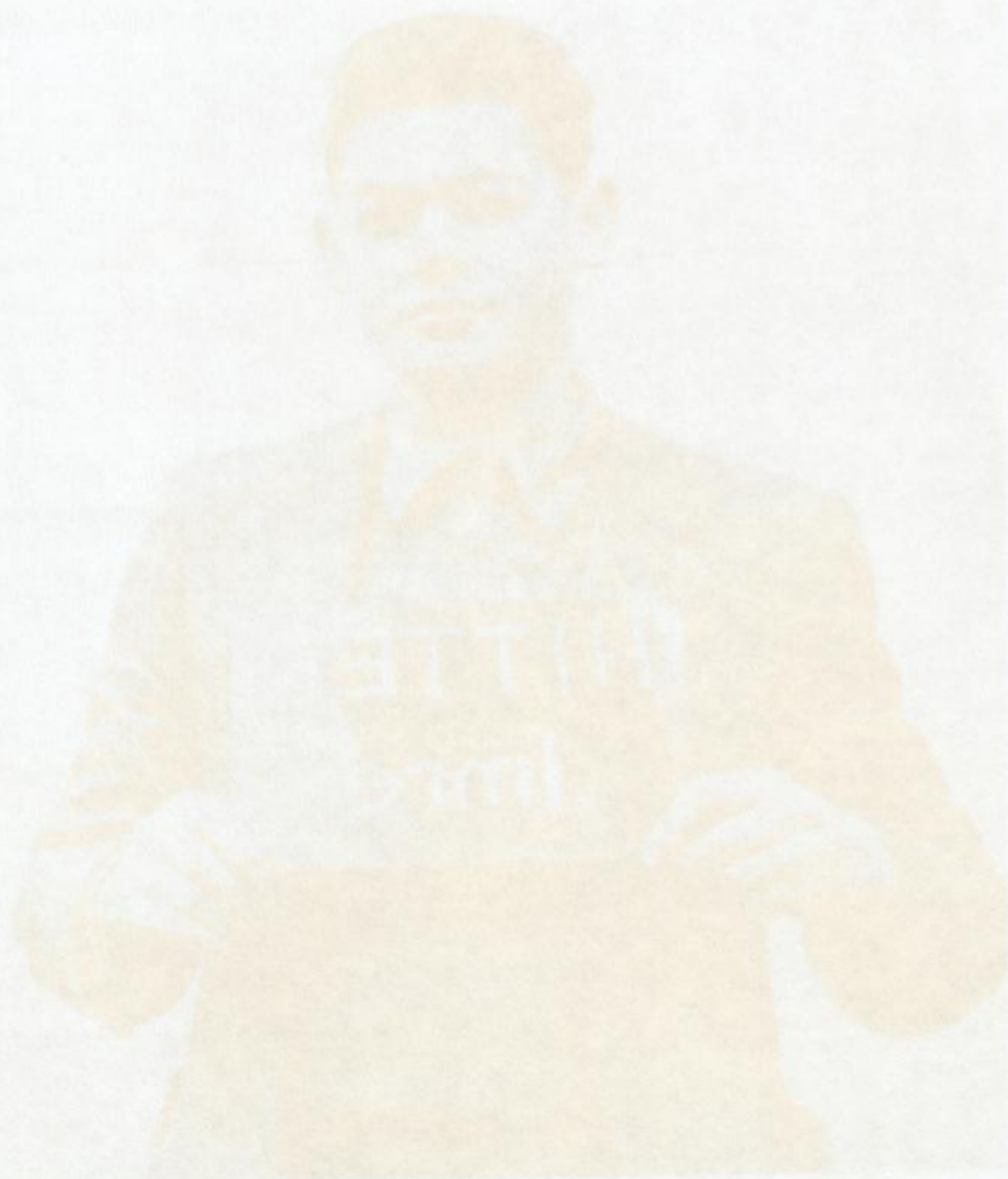

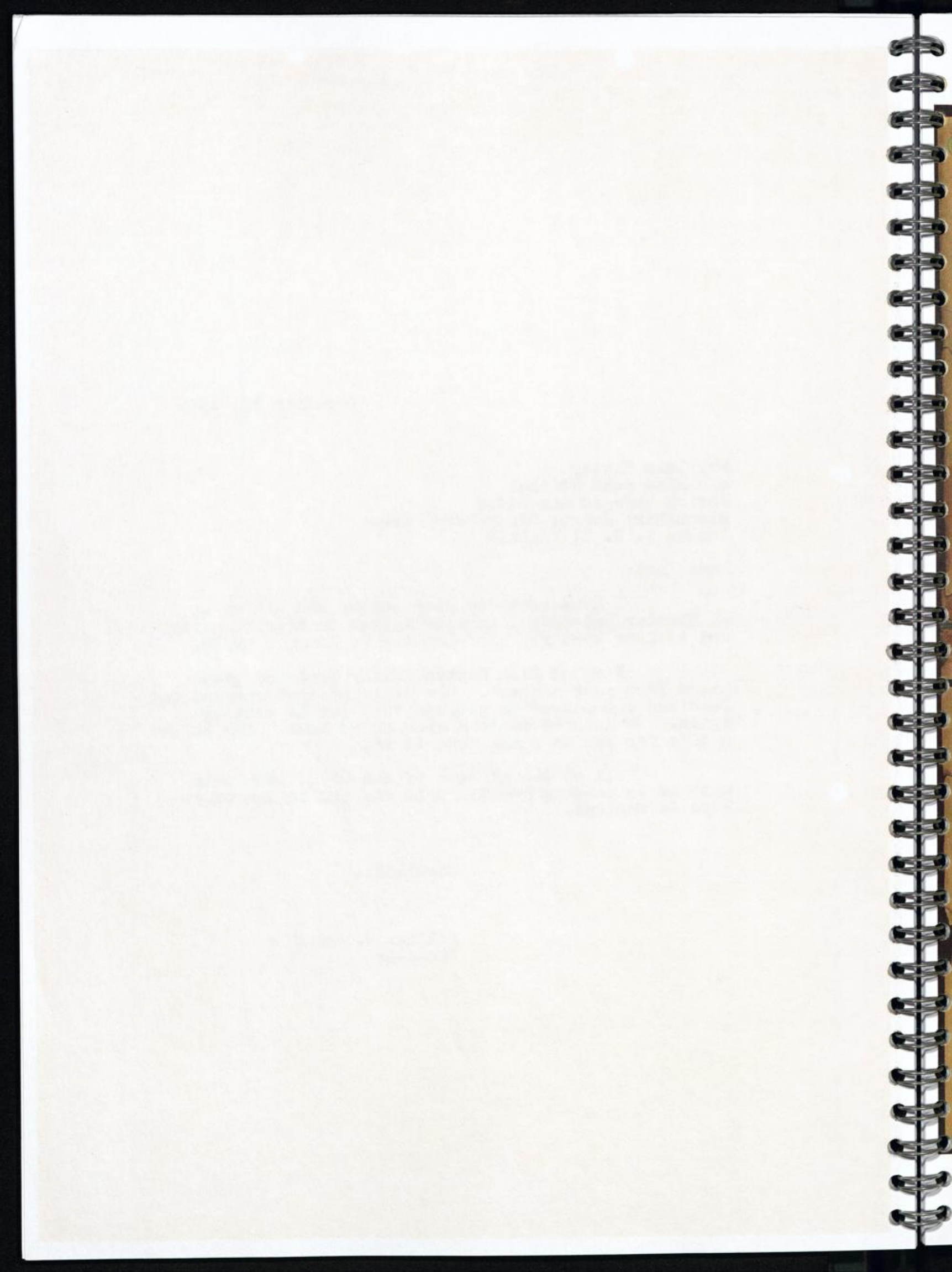
I have received your letter and all of us at Kloster Indersdorf were delighted to hear from you and to know that you are planning to learn a trade.
